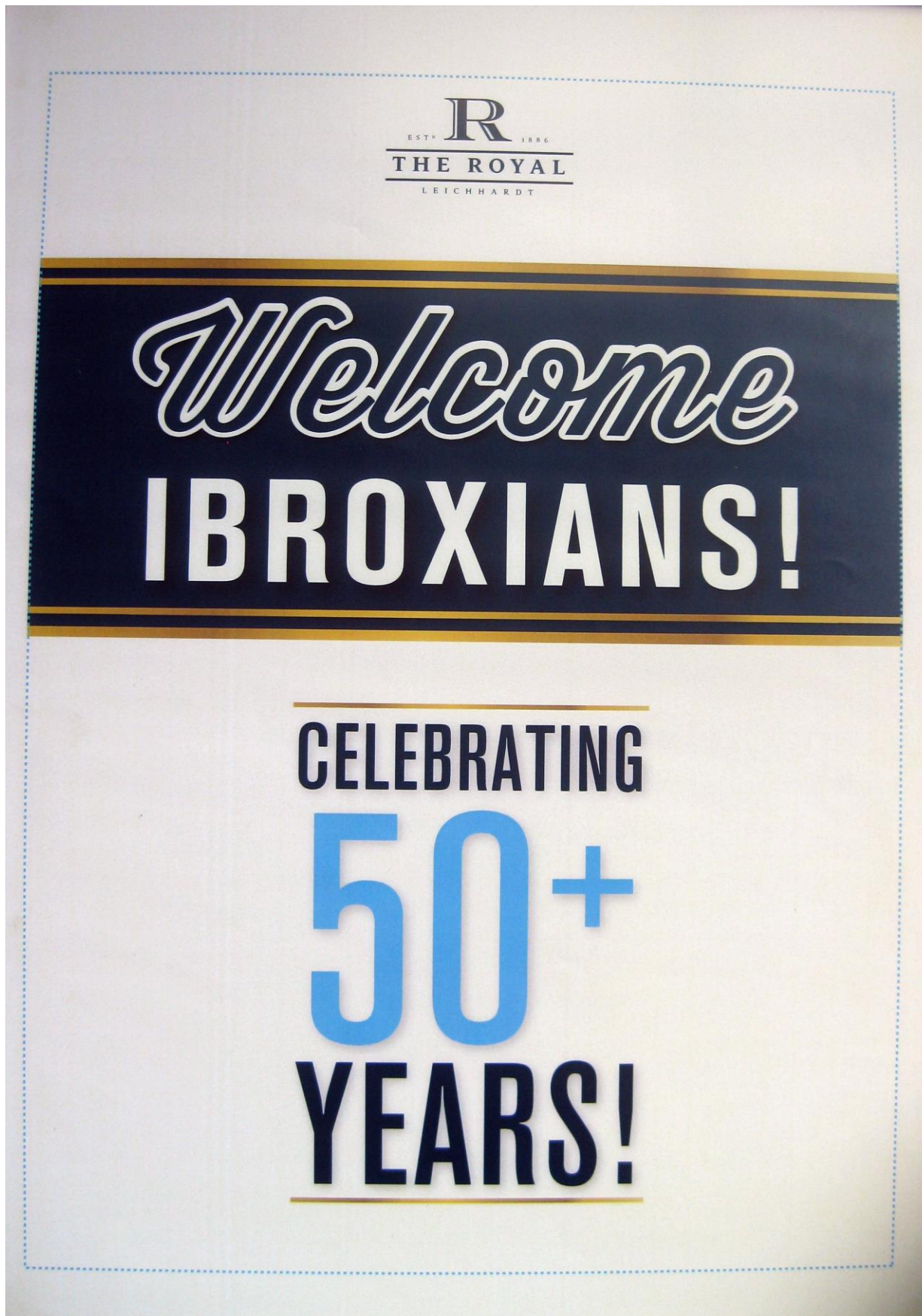

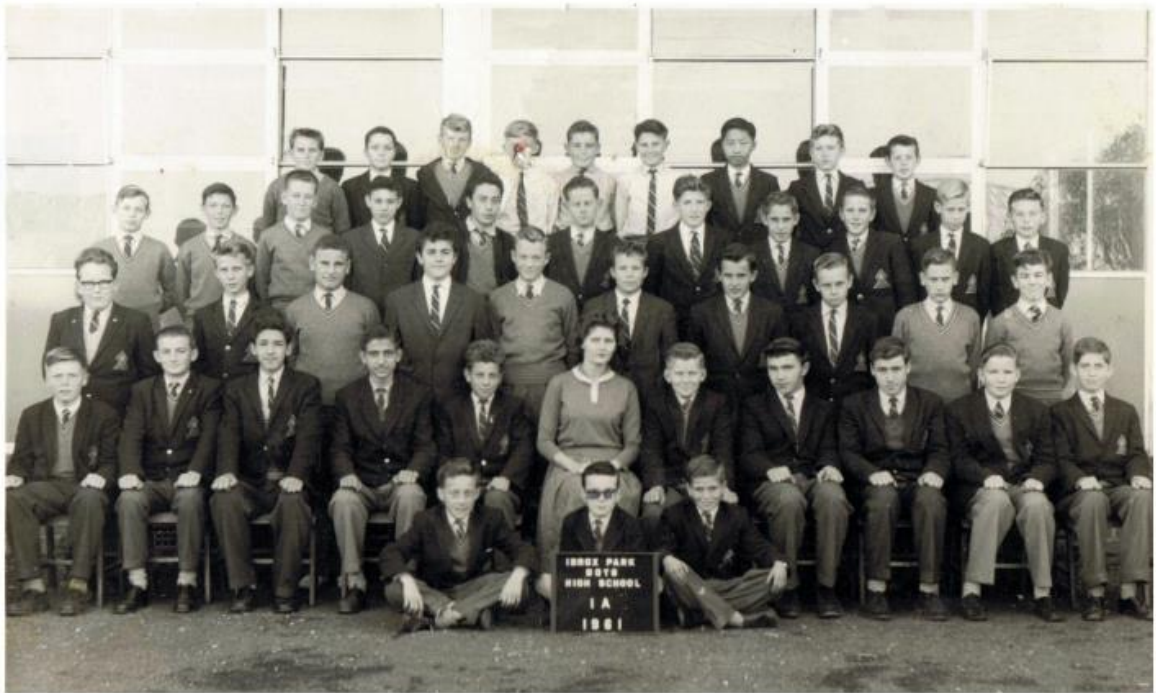

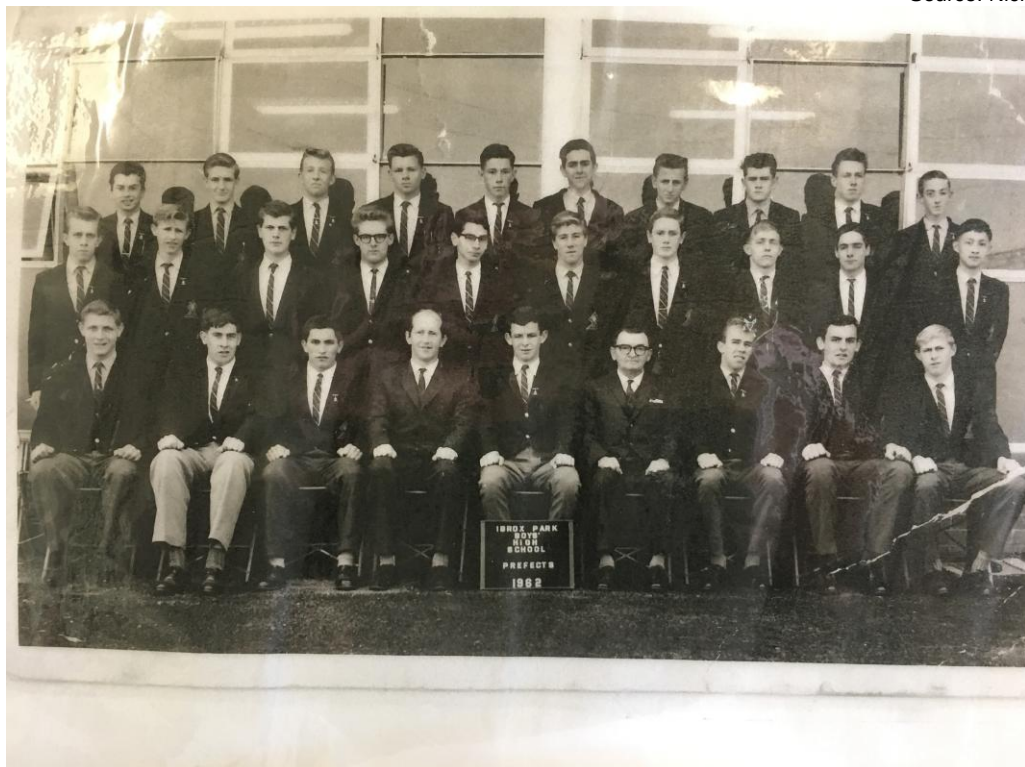

Terry Lancaster, 18, of Sydney High School, broke the open 220 yards record, 21.7s, and equalled the open 100 yards record of 9.7s. Lancaster, who holds several interclub records, is	a rangy six-footer and weighs 11st 4lb. Observers say he is a favourite to win the C.H.S. and G.P.S. sprint doubles. His nearest rival, Brian Tieste (Epping High), fell during his heat of the open 220. Tieste, who plays first-grade C.H.S. CHS boy breaks record

George Soumelides of Ibrox High broke the CHS under 14 shot-put record at E.S. Marks Field today.

Soumelides, competing in the City of Sydney zone athletic carnival, broke the record by 1ft 5ins. Clarrie Fuller, also from Ibrox High, set the record two years ago.

Athletics officials said that Soumelides' shot was an excellent feat for a 13-year-old.

When Fuller set the record two years ago, officials then believed it would be a long time before the record would be broken.

Deadbeat

Soumelides also won the shot-put event in last year's CHS championships in his age division.

Fuller holds the CHS and zone records in both shot-put and javelin.

In the under-16 mile, T. Morgan of Sydney High took 3.8 seconds off the old record.

There was a dead-heat between A. Gill of Cleveland St. and O. Lane of Sydney High in the under-15 mile.

They raced neck and neck over the last 100 yards. Both ran 9.4.3 sec.

Records were also rewritten in the under-12 and under-13 200yd sprints.

D. Masters of Fort St. took 1.1 off the old record with a run of 25.3 seconds in the under-12 200yds.

In the under-12 200yds, W. Farr of Randwick clipped 8 off the old record of 28 seconds.

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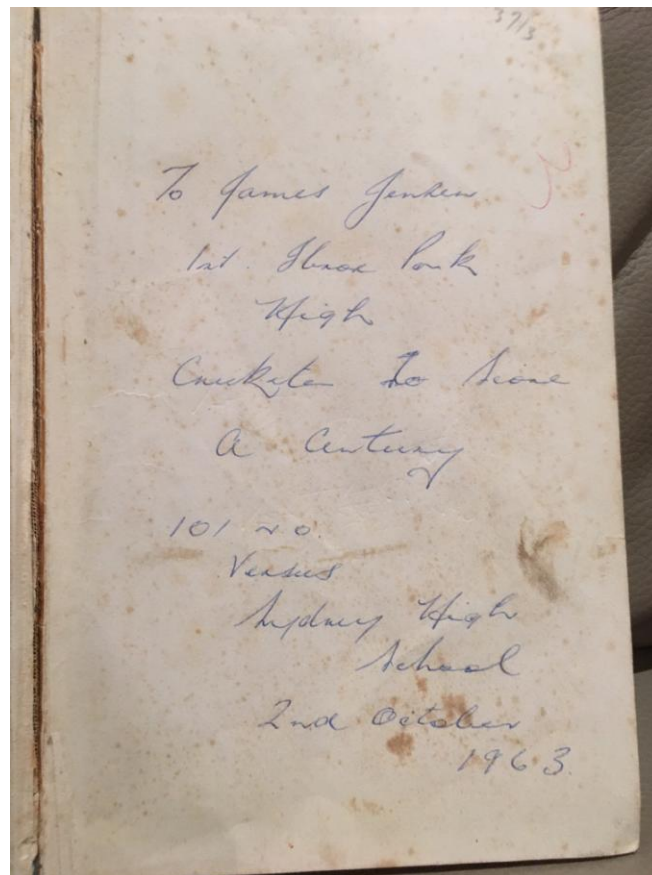

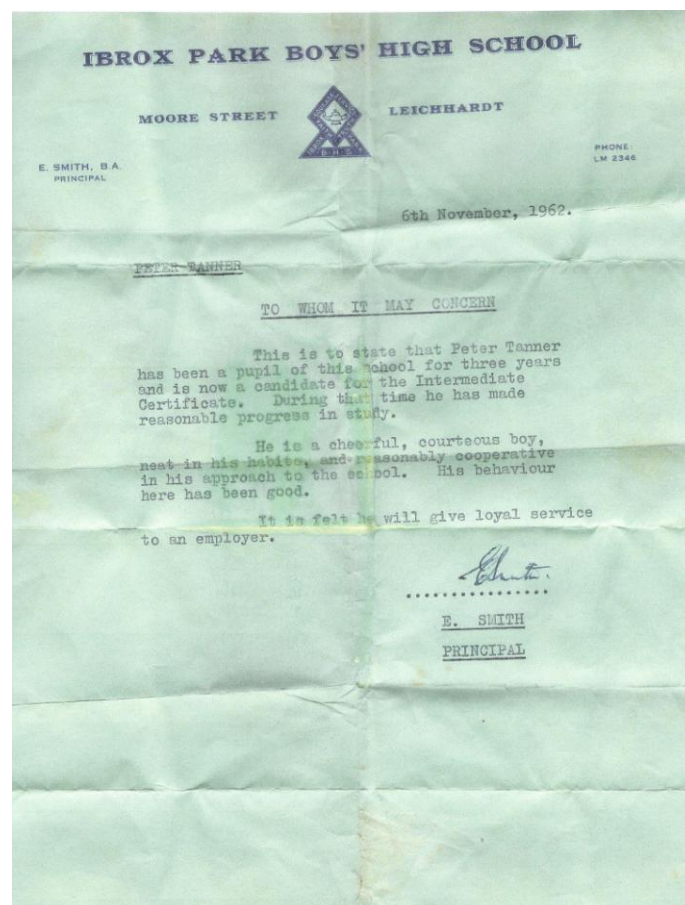
